FRUIT OF THE SPIRIT--PEACE

(Galatians 5:22,23)

INTRODUCTION:

- This peace is same peace Jesus promised. John 14:27 A.
 - It is a parting bequest to the disciples. 1.
 - They had given up all the world had to offer. Now they are left to an unfriendly 2. world.
 - Jesus could not leave them houses, land, or money. Matt.8:20 3.
 - Even the work given them was without safety promised. 4.
 - But Jesus could give them what they truly would need and what disciples still 5. desperately need--peace.
- Jesus promised this as he faced the cross. B.
 - Promise made as they now could see the peace Christ enjoyed as he faced death. 1.
 - He had no bitterness toward His enemies, but inner peace. 2.

THE SOURCE OF THIS PEACE. II.

- Jesus said "**MY** peace I given unto you." A.
 - The peace which had enabled Jesus to face danger without anxiety and without fear, 1. but calmly.
 - Jesus desired this disposition for his followers. 2.
- Jesus had this peace by self-sacrifice and unfaltering obedience to the Father's will. John В. 5:30; John 8:29

HOW IS THIS PEACE BESTOWED? III.

- Jesus does not give as the world gives. John 16:33 A.
 - World seeks the peace of ease, Christ gives the peace of struggle--the harder we 1. fight the more satisfied we become. 2 Cor. 11:23-28; 2 Cor. 7:4; 2 Cor. 12:7-10
 - World seeks peace of self-contentment, Christ gives peace of self-sacrifice. Matt. 2. 16:24-26
 - World offers peace of plenty, Jesus teaches man is more than possessions. Luke 3. 12:15-21
- Jesus gives us peace by bringing us to the same source of peace from which he obtained Β. his. Phil.3:7-11; 2 Tim. 1:12; 2 Tim. 4:6-8
- The peace of Christ reaches the heart and conscience, brought through knowing one is C. in Christ and faithful.
- The peace of the Lord brings us into peace with the faithful. Col.3:12-15; Isa.11:6-9 D.

THE POWER OF THE LORD'S PEACE. IV.

- This peace is an antidote for all our dismay and despondency. John 14:1-6; Phil. 4:6,7 A.
